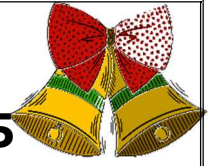

# CONCEPTS FOR AA WORLD SERVICE

## Concept XII

*General Warranties of the Conference: in all its proceedings, the General Service Conference shall observe the spirit of the A.A. Tradition, taking great care that the conference never becomes the seat of perilous wealth or power; that sufficient operating funds, plus an ample reserve, be its prudent financial principle; that none of the Conference Members shall ever be placed in a position of unqualified authority over any of the others; that all important decisions be reached by discussion, vote, and whenever possible, by substantial unanimity; that no Conference action ever be personally punitive or an incitement to public controversy; that though the Conference may act for the service of Alcoholics Anonymous, it shall never perform any acts of government; and that, like the Society of Alcoholics Anonymous which it serves, the Conference itself will always remain democratic in thought and action.*

### AI Overview

In Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) concepts, "warranties" refer to the solemn commitments in **Concept 12**, ensuring the General Service Conference (GSC) serves AA faithfully, stays democratic, avoids power/wealth, and upholds spiritual principles like no personal punishment or government actions, acting as a safeguard for A.A.'s unity and freedom.

### Key Meanings of the Warranties:

- **Spiritual Foundation:** GSC implements the spirit of Traditions, acting with prudence and spirituality.
- **No Perilous Power:** The Conference avoids becoming a seat of great wealth or power.
- **Prudent Finance:** Maintaining sufficient funds and reserves.
- **No Unqualified Authority:** No member should have absolute power over others.
- **Democratic Decisions:** Decisions come through discussion, vote, and substantial unanimity.
- **No Personal Punishment:** Actions must not be punitive or incite personal controversy.
- **No Acts of Government:** The Conference serves AA but does not govern it.
- **Democratic Spirit:** The Conference remains democratic in thought and action, like the Fellowship.
